AMEND Senate Bill No. 2089*

House Bill No. 2135

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-1302(a), is amended by deleting subdivisions (1) and (2) and substituting instead:

(1) Beginning with the 2020-2021 school year, each LEA shall locally devise, adopt, and implement a program of family life education in conformance with the curriculum guidelines established for such programs by this section.

(2) Each LEA shall locally develop and adopt a family life curriculum in compliance with the requirements of this part, or shall adopt the family life curriculum adopted by the state board of education.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 2, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

(a) A person shall not make abortion referrals or otherwise advocate or encourage abortion while the person is present on school property or while the person is present at, or engaged in, any LEA- or school-sponsored activity, program, or event required as part of the person's employment or contract with an LEA or public school, or required as part of the person's provision of services to an LEA or public school.

(b) As used in this section, "person" means an individual, partnership, committee, association, corporation, or any other organization or group of persons:

(1) Employed by, or under contract with, an LEA or public school, including public charter schools; or

(2) Providing services, including volunteer services, to an LEA or public school, including public charter schools.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.

AMEND Senate Bill No. 1739

House Bill No. 1688*

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-1021, is amended by deleting subsection (a) and substituting instead the following:

(a) Each LEA shall integrate:

(1) For students in kindergarten through grade two (K-2), a minimum of two (2) fifteen-minute periods of physical activity into each school day;

(2) For elementary school students other than students in kindergarten through grade two (K-2), a minimum of one hundred thirty (130) minutes of physical activity into each school week; and

(3) For middle and high school students, a minimum of ninety (90) minutes of physical activity into each school week.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-1021(b), is amended by deleting the language "subdivision (a)(1)" and substituting instead "subdivision (a)(2)".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-1021(d), is amended by designating the existing language as subdivision (1) and adding the following as a new subdivision:

(2) One (1) of the two (2) periods of physical activity required for each school day under subdivision (a)(1) for students in kindergarten through grade two (K-2) may be satisfied by the students' participation in a physical education class, if the class meets for a minimum of fifteen (15) minutes. An LEA shall not replace a physical education class for students in kindergarten through grade two (K-2) with a period of physical activity under subdivision (a)(1).

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it, and shall apply to the 2020-2021 school year and each school year thereafter.
