**AMEND Senate Bill No. 2124\***

**House Bill No. 2505**

by deleting from § 71-7-102(a) in the amendatory language of SECTION 1 the language "is administratively attached to the bureau of TennCare, and".

**AND FURTHER AMEND** by deleting from § 71-7-102(a)(1)(D) in the amendatory language of SECTION 1 the language "one (1) geneticist licensed and practicing in this state" and substituting instead the language "one (1) geneticist or genetic counselor licensed and practicing in this state;"

**AND FURTHER AMEND** by deleting § 71-7-102(f)(2) in the amendatory language of SECTION 1 and substituting instead the following:

(2) The governor shall call the initial meeting of the advisory council no later than October 1, 2020, for the purpose of electing a chair, vice chair, and secretary. The council is solely the administrative responsibility of the chair, and all subsequent meetings of the council must be called in accordance with this subsection (f). The bureau of TennCare is responsible only for submitting minutes compiled by the advisory council to the TennCare pharmacy advisory committee and the TennCare prescription drug utilization review committee.

**AND FURTHER AMEND** by deleting from § 71-7-103(a)(1) in the amendatory language of SECTION 1 the language "The Tennessee rare disease advisory council shall advise the DUR and the PAC" and substituting instead the language "The Tennessee rare disease advisory council shall advise the DUR, the PAC, and other state entities".

**AND FURTHER AMEND** by inserting the following new section immediately preceding SECTION 2 and renumbering SECTION 2 as a new SECTION 3:



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SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-243(a), is amended by adding the following new subdivision:

( ) Tennessee rare disease advisory council, created by § 71-7-101;

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**AMEND Senate Bill No. 2665**

**House Bill No. 2860\***

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 71-3-105, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(h) Notwithstanding subdivision (f)(2), if a state or federal state of emergency or disaster is declared, then the department is authorized to award qualified eligible families temporary assistance grants in amounts up to one hundred percent (100%) greater than the grant amounts for which the families have otherwise been determined eligible pursuant to department rule as provided by this section for a period of time not to exceed twelve (12) months.

SECTION 2. The commissioner of human services may promulgate rules to effectuate this act. The rules must be promulgated in accordance with the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, compiled in title 4, chapter 5.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.



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
