**AMEND Senate Bill No. 2688**

**House Bill No. 2520\***

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 7, Chapter 86, is amended by adding the following:

(a) By June 30, 2021, the Tennessee Emergency Communications Board (TECB) shall promulgate rules in accordance with title 4, chapter 5 to establish uniform operating standards (Model Standards) for all of this state's 911 emergency communications districts (ECD). The model standards must:

- (1) Include uniform dispatching requirements and standards; and
- (2) Require all ECD's be staffed by ECD paid employees or contract workers.

(b) Each ECD has until June 30, 2026 to adopt and implement the model standards. An ECD that fails to adopt and implement the model standards by June 30, 2026 will thereafter only receive seventy-five percent (75%) of the 911 user surcharge fees the ECD would have been entitled to through the TECB. The TECB will retain twenty-five percent (25%) of the user surcharge fees from this ECD until the ECD is in compliance with the model standards.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
