**Department: Labor & Workforce Development/Employment Security**  
**Contractor: Bull HN Information Systems, Inc.**  
**Summary: The vendor is currently responsible for the provision of remote hosting and technical support, and disaster recovery for the State’s General Comprehensive Operating System. The proposed amendment extends the contract for one year through September 30, 2012, and increases the maximum liability by \$928,056.**  
**Current maximum liability: \$2,547,660**  
**Maximum liability w/amendment \$3,475,716**
