**Summary: The vendor is responsible for statewide managed care services for physical health services, behavioral health services, and long term services for eligible TennCare enrollees. The proposed amendment revises the scope of services to provide specific language changes regarding LTSS, Quality Oversight, minimum net worth requirements, CMS Health Insurer Fee requirements, and transportation clarifications.**
