**Department: Finance and Administration**

**Division: Health Care Finance and Administration/Bureau of TennCare**

**Vendor: UnitedHealthCare Plan of the River Valley, Inc.**

**Summary: The vendor is responsible for medical and behavioral health services for TennCare enrollees in West Tennessee. The proposed amendment contains several language updates, clarifications, and deletions; adds payment reform requirements; includes current capitation rates; extends the current contract an additional six months through December 31, 2014; and increases maximum liability by \$410,935,000.**

**Current maximum liability: \$3,927,805,500**

**Proposed maximum liability: \$4,338,740,500**

After review, the Fiscal Review Committee voted to recommend approval of the contract amendment.
