Department: Safety and Homeland Security/Tennessee Highway Patrol

Vendor: Appriss, Inc.

Summary: The vendor is responsible for the development and implementation of the Records Management System as well as support and maintenance of the current Tennessee Integrated Traffic Analysis Network (TITAN) system. The proposed amendment revises the scope of services to require the vendor to provide a mechanism to offer crash reports and data extracts for sale on-line at no additional cost to the State. Requires the vendor to charge and collect a fee for each crash report sold. Current maximum liability: \$5,140,000 Proposed maximum liability: \$5,140,000

After review, the Fiscal Review Committee voted to recommend approval of the contract amendment.
