**Summary: The proposed contract is to allow agencies to continue to purchase new Geographic Information System (GIS) software as well as maintain existing software. Twenty-one different state agencies use GIS software. The Office for Information Resources (OIR) and most local governments use this software to collect and analyze geographic information. The proposed contract has a term beginning January 1, 2015, and ending January 14, 2016, with the option to extend in one-year increments for a total of five years.**

After review, the Fiscal Review Committee vote to recommend approval of the contract request.
