**Vendor: Desire2Learn, Inc.**

**Summary: The original contract was for an on-line management system and hosting services for the Regents Online Campus Collaborative. The proposed amendment adds a software license to be used by students as an analytic tool to evaluate their aptitude for potential courses; increases the maximum liability by \$886,657; extends current contract an additional year through December 31, 2014; and adds the *Prohibition of Illegal Immigrants* language.**

**Current maximum liability: \$11,727,860**

**Proposed maximum liability: \$12,614,517**

After review, the Fiscal Review Committee voted to recommend approval of the contract amendment.
