Vendor: Cambridge Systematics, Inc.

Summary: The vendor is responsible for development and management of the Commercial Vehicle Information Systems Network (CVISN) Program and its related Performance and Registration Information Systems Management (PRISM) Program. The proposed amendment extends the current contract an additional five years; increases maximum liability by \$780,000; revises payment methodology; and adds standard template language.

Current maximum liability: \$714,300

Proposed maximum liability: \$1,494,300

After review, the Fiscal Review Committee vote to recommend approval of the contract amendment with the stipulation that the extension be for three years with two one-year options with a corresponding reduction in the maximum liability.
