

SENATE BILL 3037

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40, Chapter 33, Part 2 and Title 55, Chapter 50, Part 5, relative to forfeitures. This act makes appropriations for the department of safety for the 1998-99 fiscal year.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-33-211(c)(1), is amended by deleting the language "Thirty percent (30%)" and substituting instead the language "Fifty percent (50%)".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-33-211(c)(2), is amended by deleting the language "The remaining Seventy percent (70%)" and substituting instead the language "The remaining Fifty percent (50%)".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-33-211(f)(1), is amended by deleting the language "Thirty percent (30%)" and substituting instead the language "Fifty percent (50%)".

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-33-211(f)(2), is amended by deleting the language "The remaining Seventy percent (70%)" and substituting instead the language "The remaining Fifty percent (50%)".

SECTION 5. In addition to any other funds appropriated by law, there is appropriated for the 1998-99 fiscal year an additional one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to the department of safety for two (2) additional administrative law judges to hear the forfeiture hearings required by law.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1998, the public welfare requiring it.
