

FISCAL NOTE

HB 1539 - SB 1716

March 10, 1997

SUMMARY OF BILL: Makes it a Class C misdemeanor for the parent or guardian of a person under the age of 21 to allow such person to possess or purchase beer, wine or other alcoholic beverage. A violation would be punishable by a fine only, for the first offense, of \$50; for each succeeding offense within a two-year period a violation becomes a Class B misdemeanor, punishable by a fine only of \$100.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Govt. Revenues - Not Significant

Impact depends upon the number of persons convicted of this offense and the resulting increased revenues to local governments from fines levied and collected under the provisions of this bill.
