

FISCAL NOTE

HB 1680 - SB 1822

April 11, 1997

SUMMARY OF BILL: Changes the penalty for purchasing beer for minors from a Class C to a Class A misdemeanor and makes the imposition of 30 hours of community service currently allowed in the law permissive. The bill also increases the fine from \$50 to \$500 for a person under 18 providing false information to purchase beer, and increases the *maximum* fine from \$200 to \$500 for a person between 18 and 21 providing false information to purchase beer.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Govt. Revenues - Not Significant
Increase Local Govt. Expenditures - Not Significant

Impact depends upon the number of persons convicted of this offense and the resulting increased cost to local governments to confine such persons versus the increased revenues to local governments from fines levied and collected under the provisions of this bill.
