

FISCAL NOTE

HB 2593 - SB 2897

January 29, 1998

SUMMARY OF BILL: Provides for directional signs for Fort Southwest Point in Roane County on Interstate 40 at Exit 352, both eastbound and westbound. This act shall become operative only if the federal highway administrator advises the commissioner of transportation in writing that the provisions of this act shall not render Tennessee in violation of federal laws and regulations.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$10,000 One-Time Highway Fund

Assumes fabrication and erection of two (2) interstate signs @ \$4,000 each and two (2) ramp signs @ \$1,000 each.
