

FISCAL NOTE

SB 1400 - HB 1453

March 30, 1998

SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates a mandatory minimum fine of \$750, \$850, and \$1,000 for first, second and third convictions for a misdemeanor drug offense involving a substance classified as a Schedule I through V controlled substance.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Govt. Revenues - Exceeds \$100,000

Assumes a significant number of misdemeanor drug offenders involving a Schedule I through V controlled substances will pay a mandatory fine.
