

FISCAL NOTE

SB 1447 - HB 935

February 24, 1997

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases the penalty for the delivery or sale of a Schedule I, II, III, IV, or V controlled substance to one classification higher when a minor is present.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$88,200/Incarceration*

Assumes one conviction for each schedule of controlled substance elevated to the next higher classification.

*Section 9-6-119, TCA, requires that: *For any law enacted after July 1, 1986, which results in a net increase in periods of imprisonment in state facilities, there shall be appropriated from recurring revenues the estimated operating cost of such law.*
