

# FISCAL NOTE

## SB 1448 - HB 1571

March 4, 1997

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Revises the law to allow only wine and beer at zoological institutions, and allows such beverages to be sold during regular operating hours. Current law allows wine, beer and other alcoholic beverages to be sold only during special events scheduled for fund-raising purposes.

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Increase State Revenues - Not Significant**  
**Increase Local Govt. Revenues - Not Significant**

Assumes some increase in applicable state and local tax revenues to the extent that beer and wine are sold at zoological institutions when such institutions are open to the general public. The estimate assumes, based on conversations with affected institutions, that they will not sell significant amounts of beer and wine during regular operating hours.
