

FISCAL NOTE

SB 1788 - HB 1686

April 1, 1997

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Department of Health to license facilities providing supportive residential services for HIV positive patients. The residences are authorized to admit such persons under a physician's order and are required to establish policies for administering the facility. The bill creates standards for case management, facility administration, handling of prescriptions and medical care. The department is authorized to license, inspect and sanction a licensed residence but is not authorized to establish and collect license fees.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$40,000
Decrease State Revenues - Less Than \$100,000

Assumes that the Department of Health will need one staff person to regulate these facilities.

Assumes a loss of revenue from some existing Residential Homes for the Aged converting their license to this status.

Bill does not provide for the establishment of license fees.
