

# FISCAL NOTE

## SB 1862 - HB 1916

March 8, 1997

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Authorizes the court or the Board of Paroles to require an offender, as a condition of probation, community corrections, or parole, to obtain substance abuse treatment.

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Minimal**

The courts and the Board of Paroles are currently authorized to require substance abuse treatment as a condition of probation or parole.
