

FISCAL NOTE

SB 2652 - HB 2636

March 4, 1998

SUMMARY OF BILL: Makes it a Class A misdemeanor to possess a firearm on the premises of an establishment where 50% of the gross sales are from the sales of alcoholic beverages. Current law makes such possession an offense in *any* establishment where alcoholic beverages are served.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Decrease Local Govt. Revenues - Not Significant
Decrease Local Govt. Expenditures - Not Significant

Impact depends upon the decreased number of convictions and the resulting decreased cost to local governments to confine such persons versus the decreased revenues to local governments from fines that will not be levied or collected under the provisions of this bill that would have been levied and collected in the absence of the bill.
