

FISCAL NOTE

SB 2937 - HB 3159

March 2, 1998

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires that 85 percent of the sentence be served for a conviction for aggravated robbery.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$42,396,200/Incarceration*

Assumes 550 persons convicted every year will serve a sentence increased from a minimum of 2.4 years to a minimum of 6.8 years.

*Section 9-6-119, TCA, requires that: *For any law enacted after July 1, 1986, which results in a net increase in periods of imprisonment in state facilities, there shall be appropriated from recurring revenues the estimated operating cost of such law.*
