

FISCAL NOTE

SB 3021 - HB 2646

February 24, 1998

SUMMARY OF BILL: Adds to current law that certified security officers/guards, correction officers and probation officers, in addition to law enforcement officers, if exposed to bodily fluids during arrest, may have such bodily fluids tested for hepatitis B virus and HIV virus. The person arrested is to pay for such testing.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - Not Significant
Increase State Revenues - Not Significant
Increase Local Govt. Expenditures - Not Significant
Increase Local Govt. Revenues - Not Significant

Assumes more testing for hepatitis B and HIV and more collections from offenders to offset cost.
