

FISCAL NOTE

SB 3199 - HB 3134

March 16, 1998

SUMMARY OF BILL: Defines *reasonably adequate service* to mean the telephone cooperatives have met certain criteria. After satisfying this criteria, telephone cooperatives may provide telecommunications services in an adjoining service area upon application to the Tennessee Regulatory Authority for a certificate of public convenience and necessity. Allows the Tennessee Regulatory Authority to promulgate rules to establish standards for telecommunications services.
