AMEND Senate Bill No. 2351*

House Bill No. 2760

By deleting all of the language after the enacting clause and by substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-10-412(e), is amended in subdivision (6) by deleting the language and punctuation “; and such fees related to the ignition interlock that are paid by the offender shall be applied as a credit to any fines assessed against the offender as a result of a conviction of the violation of §§ 55-10-401 – 55-10-404 which resulted in the order for the ignition interlock device”.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-10-412(l)(1), is amended by deleting the language “A person’s second or subsequent violation” and by substituting instead the language “A person’s second or subsequent conviction”.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
