AMEND Senate Bill No. 1897

House Bill No. 1925*

By adding a new section to be appropriately designated:

Section ____ (a) Any individual or family enrolled in the TennCare program by reason of uninsured or uninsurable status, whose income is at or above two hundred and fifty percent (250%) of the federal poverty level shall also pay a minimum twenty percent (20%) copayment for all nonpreventative services.

(b) Any individual or family enrolled in the TennCare program by reason of uninsured or uninsurable status whose income is at or above two hundred and fifty (250%) percent of the federal poverty level shall be provided a benefits package that does not exceed any HMO group insurance plan for state employees.

(c) The provisions of this act shall be construed so as to be consistent with the terms of any federal waiver and controlling federal law requirement for the provision of federally authorized medical assistance.
