**AMEND Senate Bill No. 3107**

**House Bill No. 3035**

by adding the following new section immediately preceding the last section and by renumbering the subsequent section accordingly:

SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, on or before July 1, 2001, the standards committees established by Sections 12 and 35 and the child care advisory council established under Section 39 shall recommend to the commissioners of human services and children's services and to the state board of education, as appropriate, new standards and regulations concerning for mandatory orientation and training requirements for caregivers providing care at any child-caring institution, child care program or child-care center. Such requirements shall include preservice orientation and at least four (4) hours of annual inservice training. Such standards shall require that a child-caring institution, child care program or child care-center demonstrate that all of its care-givers have completed orientation and training, approved or delivered by the department, prior to receiving a temporary license or license renewal.
