

HOUSE BILL 1510

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-705, relative to the receiving, possession, transportation or delivery of any intoxicating liquor or alcoholic beverages by a common or other carrier in certain circumstances.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-705, is amended by adding the following language as a new subdivision (6):

(6) Any common or other carrier to receive, possess, transport, or deliver any intoxicating liquor or alcoholic beverages into or within this state, provided the common carrier or other carrier, absent reckless or intentional conduct, and in good faith, cooperates with the state or federal government, through legal processes, by reporting or investigating or both, allegations or violations of this state's intoxicating liquor or alcoholic beverage laws and regulations by manufacturers, wholesalers, distributors, retailers or other shippers of intoxicating liquors or alcoholic beverages.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
