

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 179

A RESOLUTION to designate a certain segment of U.S. Highway 31 in Davidson County as the "Mansfield Douglas, III, Highway".

WHEREAS, from time to time this General Assembly has acknowledged the need to name certain public byways in honor of those outstanding persons whose incomparable achievements greatly benefited their communities and fellow citizens; and

WHEREAS, Mansfield Douglas, III, is one such person, whose life of principle and commitment as a Metro Councilman will be long remembered by the good people of Davidson County he so capably served through the years; and

WHEREAS, seldom do persons of Mansfield Douglas's character, integrity and brilliance shine so brightly upon us, and it is most appropriate that a lasting tribute be erected to this peerless man; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, That in honor of this great humanitarian, the segment of U.S.

Highway 31 in Davidson County, from Edgehill Avenue to Woodmont Boulevard, is hereby designated as the "Mansfield Douglas, III, Highway".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable signs or to affix suitable markers designating such segment of U.S. Highway 31 in Davidson County, as the "Mansfield Douglas, III, Highway".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the erection of such directional signs shall be within the guidelines prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall become operative only if the federal highway administrator advises the commissioner of transportation in writing that the provisions of this resolution shall not render Tennessee in violation of federal laws and regulations and subject to penalties prescribed therein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a certified copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Commissioner of Transportation.
