HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 593

A RESOLUTION to designate a bridge spanning Hinkle Branch in Carter County as the "Earl Graham Bridge".

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE-HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, SENATE CONCURRING, That in honor of a distinguished gentleman who was renowned for his stalwart commitment and dedication to perpetuating the common good, the bridge that spans State Route 91 over Hinkle Branch at the intersection of Laurel Hollow Road and State Route 91 at approximately mile marker 17 at the foot of Cross Mountain in Carter County is hereby designated the "Earl Graham Bridge".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of Transportation is hereby directed to erect suitable signs or to affix suitable markers designating such bridge as the "Earl Graham Bridge".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the erection of such signs shall be within the guidelines prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That in the instance of a new bridge being erected to replace such bridge, the new bridge shall also be designated as the "Earl Graham Bridge" and

the Department of Transportation shall erect or transfer suitable signs or markers to appropriately indicate such designation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, This resolution shall become operative only if the federal highway administrator advises the commissioner of transportation in writing that the provisions of this resolution shall not render Tennessee in violation of federal laws and regulations and subject to penalties prescribed therein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That an enrolled copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Commissioner of Transportation.
