

SENATE BILL 889

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 57-4-101, 57-4-102, 57-4-201, 57-4-203 and 57-4-301, relative to alcoholic beverages at race meetings conducted by an association.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-101, is amended by adding the following new subsection to be appropriately designated:

() It is lawful to sell wine and other alcoholic beverages as defined in Section 57-4-102, and beer as defined in Section 57-6-102, to be consumed on the premises of any association as hereinafter defined to those in attendance at such association facility subject to the further provisions of this chapter.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102, is amended by adding the following definition:

() "Association" has the same meaning used in Section 4-36-103(1); provided, however, the provisions of this chapter shall only apply to a person actually licensed to conduct a race meeting and provided, further, the provisions of this chapter shall not apply to any fair as defined in Section 4-36-103(6).

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-201(b)(1), is amended by inserting in the third sentence the language "or of an association as defined in Section 57-4-102," between the words "as defined in Section 57-4-102," and the word "shall".

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-201, is further amended by deleting the language "or sports authority facility" and substituting instead the language " , sports authority facility or association" in subdivisions (d)(2) and (d)(6).

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-203(d)(1), is amended by deleting the language "and urban park centers" and substituting instead the language " , associations and urban park centers".

SECTION 6. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-301(b)(1), is amended by adding the following new subdivision:

() Association300.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
