AN ACT to establish a pilot project for youth agricultural programs at Roane State Community College. This act appropriates a sum certain to implement the provisions of this act in fiscal year 1999-2000.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created a pilot project to develop and administer summer 4-H agricultural programs for young people at the Henry-Stafford Exposition Center at Roane State Community College in Harriman.

SECTION 2. The purpose of this pilot project is to provide young people with access to real-life farming and livestock experiences during the summer break from school in order to promote civic responsibility and the agricultural profession.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to fund the pilot project created by this act in fiscal year 1999-2000.

SECTION 4. The commissioner of agriculture is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations to effectuate the purposes of this act. all such rules and regulations shall be promulgated in accordance with the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 5.

SECTION 5. The pilot project created by this act shall cease to exist on July 1, 2000.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
