SENATE BILL 2783

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55 and Title 68, Chapter 212, relative to parking motor vehicles containing hazardous waste.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-162, is amended by designating the existing language subsection (a) and by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subsection (b):

(b)(1) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no person shall leave unattended or unsecured any truck, tractor-trailer or tractor-semitrailer combination, with a rated capacity of more than one (1) ton, containing hazardous waste, including, but not limited to, medical waste, in any residential area.

(2) A violation of subdivision (1) is a Class A misdemeanor punishable only by a fine of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500).

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000, the public welfare requiring it.
