

SENATE BILL 3189

AN ACT to create a pilot project for after-care supervision services in Shelby County. This act appropriates a sum certain to implement the provisions of this act in fiscal year 2000-2001.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created a pilot project in Shelby County to provide after-care supervision services through the department of children's services.

SECTION 2. The purpose of this pilot project is to provide after-care supervision services, administered by the department of children's services, that will focus upon employment counseling, civic activities and locally-based opportunities for youth of Shelby County.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to fund the pilot project created by this act in fiscal year 2000-2001.

SECTION 4. The department of children's services is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations to effectuate the purposes of this act. All such rules shall be promulgated in accordance with the provisions of Title 4, Chapter 5.

SECTION 5. The pilot project created by this act shall cease on July 1, 2001.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
