

SENATE BILL 3199

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 10, Part 4, relative to fines.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-10-451, is amended by deleting such section in its entirety and substituting instead the following:

55-10-451. The proceeds from the increased portion of the fines for driving under the influence of an intoxicant provided for in Public Acts 1994, Chapter 948, shall be collected by the respective court clerks and then deposited in a dedicated county fund. Such fund shall not revert to the county general fund at the end of a fiscal year but shall remain for the purposes set in this section. For purposes of this section, the increased portion of the fine shall for all purposes be considered to be the first one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) collected after the initial collection of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) on a first offense, the first one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) collected after the initial collection of four hundred fifty dollars (\$450) on a second offense, and the first one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) collected after the initial collection of nine hundred fifty dollars (\$950) on a third or subsequent offense.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000, the public welfare requiring it.
