

SENATE BILL 7 of the Second Extraordinary Session

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 67.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1.

(a) Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-5-508(a)(2), is amended by deleting the language "ten (10) calendar days" and substituting instead the language "fifteen (15) calendar days".

(b) Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-5-508(a)(3), is amended by deleting the language "ten (10) calendar days" and by substituting instead the language "fifteen (15) days".

(c) Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-5-508(a)(4), is amended by deleting the subdivision in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(4) A notation of the date of any notification of a change in classification or assessed valuation, or a dated copy of such notification, shall be included in the records of the assessor; and such records shall be preserved by the assessor for not less than three (3) years.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-5-1510(a), is amended by deleting the language "ten (10) days' written notice" and by substituting instead the language "fifteen (15) days' written notice".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-5-2002(b), is amended by deleting the language "twenty (20) days" and by substituting instead "thirty (30) days".

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect January 1, 2000, the public welfare requiring it.
