

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 28

A RESOLUTION urging the Department of Transportation to erect directional signs for the Second Harvest Food Bank of Northeast Tennessee on Interstate 181 in Washington County.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, That the Department of Transportation is hereby urged and encouraged to erect and maintain directional signs for the Second Harvest Food Bank of Northeast Tennessee on Interstate 181 in Washington County at Exit 42, both northbound and southbound.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the erection of such directional signs shall be within the guidelines prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall become operative only if the federal highway administrator advises the commissioner of transportation in writing that the provisions of this act shall not render Tennessee in violation of federal laws and regulations and subject to penalties prescribed therein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That an enrolled copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Commissioner of Transportation.
