AN ACT To amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-104-112, relative to the sale and handling of fireworks.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-104-112, is amended in subsection (a) by adding to subdivision (4) the following new language:

If on the effective date of this act, a retailer, as defined by Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-104-101(6), is located in a county that has a population of less than 200,000, and if such county subsequently increases in population to the extent that a federal census establishes that it has a population of more than 200,000, then such retailer or its assignees and successors, may continue to sell D.O.T. Class C common fireworks at retail at the location specified in the retailer's permit.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
