

FISCAL NOTE

HB 908 - SB 1190

March 1, 1999

SUMMARY OF BILL: Allows persons under the age of 21 who are convicted of driving while impaired to obtain a restricted driver's license.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Revenues - Not Significant

Based on information provided by the Department of Safety, in FY97-98 there were approximately 259 convictions of drivers under the age of 21 for driving while impaired. It is estimated that an increase in state revenue for issuing restricted driver licenses would result from passage of this bill, however, the increase is estimated to be not significant.
