

# FISCAL NOTE

## HB 977 - SB 1184

March 28, 1999

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Deletes the provision making it an offense to possess a firearm in a building where alcoholic beverages are sold; retains the provision which makes it an offense for a person to possess a firearm on the premises of a place open to the public where alcoholic beverages are served. These offenses are currently punished as a Class A misdemeanor.

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Decrease Local Govt. Revenues - Not Significant**  
**Decrease Local Govt. Expenditures - Not Significant**

Impact depends upon the number of persons previously convicted of this offense and the resulting cost to local governments to confine such persons versus the revenues to local governments from fines previously levied and collected under the current law
