

# FISCAL NOTE

## HB 1459 - SB 1917

April 8, 1999

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires each agency or department of state government that is required by state or federal law or court order to enter into interagency agreements to coordinate required activities between or among state agencies, departments, or entities to execute such agreements and submit to the department of audit. Each agency or department of state government shall submit an annual interagency agreement compliance report to the department of audit by September 30, 1999 and by each September 30 thereafter. The department of audit is required to publish by January 31, 2000, and each January 31 thereafter, a cumulative report of the compliance submissions, including its findings and recommendations concerning compliance with the requirements of this section. The cumulative report shall be distributed to the governor, to each member of the general assembly, and to each library designated as a depository of state reports and documents.

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

#### **Increase State Expenditures - \$40,000**

Assumes additional audit hours to review agency documents and compile an annual report.
