

# FISCAL NOTE

## HB 2188 - SB 2774

February 17, 2000

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Increases from \$15,000 to \$25,000 the jurisdictional limits in civil cases of general sessions court and removes the \$25,000 limitation on awards of alternative money judgments in general sessions court in any county having a population of not less than 68,100 nor more than 68,400 according to the 1990 or any subsequent federal census (Anderson County).

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Decrease State Expenditures - Not Significant**  
**Increase Local Govt. Expenditures - Not Significant**

Estimate assumes some decrease in the caseloads of the circuit and chancery courts and an increase in the general sessions court caseload in Anderson County; however, the fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
