

FISCAL NOTE

HB 2376 - SB 2480

February 5, 2000

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes the issuance of special license plates for persons who repair and restore motor vehicles to be used solely for testing the repair and restoration of such vehicles on any highway within the state. Requires the person using such plates have a business license for the restoration of motor vehicles and an outbuilding for the sole purpose of conducting such business. Limits the number of plates to be issued to any one applicant to ten. Provides for a fee similar to that paid for plates issued to motor vehicle dealers.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

100 Plates @ \$42.00 each	\$4,200 Recurring
400 Plates @ \$21.50 each	\$8,600 Recurring

Expenditures

500 plates @ \$1.25 each	\$ 625 Recurring
Computer System Changes	\$2,000 One-Time

Assumes:

- 100 different businesses issued 10 plates each for a total of 500 plates.
- fee for first plate issued is \$42.00 and fee for second and subsequent plates is \$21.50.
