

FISCAL NOTE

SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates a joint study committee to examine the need for utilization review processes for mental health care and treatment of chemically dependent populations. The committee shall consist of three Representatives and three Senators appointed by the respective Speaker. The appropriate state departments are to provide assistance upon request of the Chair. The committee is to report no later than March 1, 2001 at which time the committee shall cease to exist.
