

FISCAL NOTE

SB 9 - HB 37

SUMMARY OF BILL: Provides that unless it is in best interest of the child that the biological parents have contact with the foster parents, the names and addresses of the foster parents shall not be disclosed.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - Not Significant
Increase Local Govt. Expenditures - Not Significant

Assumes some additional litigation in juvenile court involving the Department of Children's Services and the biological parents in making a "best interest" determination.
