

FISCAL NOTE

SB 30 - HB 33

January 29, 1999

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes any veterans' organization that is federally chartered with 501(c)(4) status from the IRS to sell wine, beer or other alcoholic beverages on the premises to those in attendance on the premises of the veterans' organization; provided, that such premises are located within the boundaries of a political subdivision that has authorized the sale of liquor by the drink. A license or permit would not be required in connection with the sale of such beer, wine or other alcoholic beverages.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

State Revenues - Net Impact - Not Significant
Local Govt. Revenues - Net Impact - Not Significant

Assumes that any additional revenue realized by state and local governments through collection of applicable taxes from such veterans' organizations would not exceed \$100,000. Assumes any loss of revenues from state and local license fees would not be significant.
