

FISCAL NOTE

SB 165 - HB 843

February 15, 1999

SUMMARY OF BILL: Designates the interstate highway system within the state of Tennessee as the "Senator Albert Gore, Sr. Memorial Interstate System". The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers or to affix suitable signs at the first available location at which each interstate highway enters the State of Tennessee.

This act shall become operative only if the federal highway administrator advises the commissioner of transportation in writing that the provisions of this act shall not render Tennessee in violation of federal laws and regulations.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$22,500 One-Time/Highway Fund

Estimate assumes fabrication and erection of 15 signs @ \$1,500 each.
