

FISCAL NOTE

SB 270 - HB 523

February 22, 1999

SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates an elective Office of Solicitor General; provides for the transfer of certain duties and responsibilities from the Office of the Attorney General; transfers the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation into the Office of Solicitor General.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Increase State Expenditures - \$175,000 Recurring
\$25,000 One-Time**

Estimate includes the salary for the solicitor General, one assistant and related operational expenses. One time costs includes law library, computers and office furniture.

Estimate assumes the office of Attorney General remains in existence with the duties outlined in the bill.
