

FISCAL NOTE

SB 1098 - HB 1604

April 5, 1999

SUMMARY OF BILL: Provides that wills requiring no intervention by the court may be deposited with the court clerk thus making them available as public records upon the death of the testator.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Govt. Revenues - Not Significant

Assumes local governments will experience an increase in revenues from the \$5 fee clerks collect from individuals depositing such wills. This increase is estimated to be not significant.
