

FISCAL NOTE

SB 1186 - HB 1426

March 6, 1999

SUMMARY OF BILL: Allows bed and breakfast establishments meeting certain requirements in a county having a population of not less than 800,000 to obtain a liquor-by-the-drink license.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Revenues - Not Significant

Increase Local Govt. Revenues - Not Significant

Estimate assumes that the number of bed and breakfast facilities meeting all the criteria established in the bill would be small, and that the increased tax collections by state and local governments would not be significant.
