

# **FISCAL NOTE/CAPTION BILL**

## **SB 1355 - HB 1696**

March 13, 1999

**CAPTION BILL:** Fiscal note reflects amendment filed to lift bill from Senate Clerk's desk (003635).

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Prohibits any governing authority from changing any distance between any business engaged in selling, distributing, or manufacturing beer or alcoholic beverages and any school, residence, church, or other place of public gathering without first receiving approval from the Alcoholic Beverage Commission. Notice and an opportunity to be heard shall be given before the Alcoholic Beverage Commission takes any action.

### **ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**Increase State Expenditures - \$70,000**  
**\$10,000 One-Time**

Estimate assumes an addition of two agents and related equipment to provide staff support for investigations and hearings. Such hearings expand the jurisdiction of the ABC. Currently, the ABC does not have jurisdiction to regulate the sale, manufacturing or distribution of malt beverages.
